WHAT IS THE **HOPE CENTER?**

1998

In 1998, transitioned from a grassroots movement to an official not-for-profit - an urban charter school for under served youth, focused on the old Oak Park, Ivanhoe, Palestine, and Santa Fe neighborhoods on Kansas City's east side.

2010

In 2010, THC founded Hope Family Care Center, the only primary care facility within three zip codes.

In 2011, Hope Leadership Academy opened its doors as the only elementary school in the area.


THC **VISION** "To develop healthy communities where the vulnerable can flourish."














WE RIDE IN MEMORY OF TdH FOUNDER MIKE DARBY
